

Brainstorming Blog Entry

- In a solid 1-2 paragraphs, explain your initial ideas about a topic for the research project. Be sure to indicate which of the options from the guideline sheet you are choosing (you may write about more than 1 if you haven't made a decision yet). If you would like to work in a group, you can indicate this as well to help locate other like-minded individuals. Finally, also include any questions you have at this stage that are not addressed on the guideline sheet.
- Then, comment on at least 2 peers' entries (try to seek out blogs that don't have comments so everyone gets some feedback). Your comments should be substantial--more than "great idea!" For instance, indicate some directions for the research topic or perspectives the writer could consider, or sources that will likely be useful to the writer. You may also use the commenting feature to organize a collaboration team.
